

MSCT have been in contact with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) regarding the alignment of the relevant sector codes to the recently amended B-BBEE codes of Good Practice. The response from the DTI, was that they would be in contact with the relevant sector councils and determine what the new dates of implementation would be and then to revert back to the industry.

Understandably, the DTI have been under immense pressure due to the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic. In saying this, the Sector Codes which have been gazetted will remain in effect until such time further clarification is presented to us by the Department of Trade and Industry.


Changes within MSCT
